This verse reminds us of a special truth. God created us to glorify Him by enjoying Him forever. God wants us to experience our highest joy and our greatest happiness in Him.

What does it mean that joy in God is "inexpressibly" great? Does this mean that it's impossible to express our joy in God?

- It means that God and His blessings are greater, more valuable, than we can fully express.
- We can still worship God now by how we live our lives, and by enjoying everything that God is and does and promises to do.

How can we enjoy God?

- We can enjoy God by spending time in the Bible and prayer every day.
- We can enjoy God by thinking about His many blessings and relying on His promises.
- We can enjoy God by reminding ourselves of the gospel, that God has saved us through Christ.
- We can treasure God by memorizing His word, hiding it in our heart like precious jewels.

- We can magnify God's name by telling others about Him, and about His son Jesus Christ.
