## Meet the Canns

Zach, Cassidy,  
Jude and Oliver

*In addition to our regular mission partners, this year CrossWay is financially supporting missionary couple, Zach and Cassidy Cann. Zach was a member of CrossWay a few years ago while a student at Trinity Seminary. Below is a summary of their mission in Papua New Guinea.*

Zach and Cassidy Cann arrived in Papua New Guinea in December of 2014. In June of 2015 they relocated to the Ndo tribe in the village of Mawerero. They and their team of three families have a goal of making disciples in the Finesterre Mountains, and to that end will work to learn the tribal language, develop a written language for the tribe, teach them how to read, teach them the word of God in their language, and translate the Bible. They have been living among the people and developing wonderful relationships, and will continue over the next two years observing the tribe, in hopes of better understanding the culture and aiding and further building of relationships and language skills. God has made their time fruitful and they have already seen growth in bringing the Word in a way that knowledgeably combats the current thinking and feeling of this specific tribe. They desire that the people see their need for a Savior and over the next six months plan to teach from Genesis to the cross, revealing God as Creator, Judge, and Redeemer. Please pray with us that God would open blind eyes to see Jesus as the only sin-forgiver, wrath-remover, and righteousness-provider. Our final goal, if God wills, is to establish a self-sustaining church that desires to preach God and his word to their neighboring tribes.
