1. What are some ways you can honor your parents?

- ☆ Obey your parents (Eph. 6:1). Do what they tell you to do without arguing or complaining.
- ☆ Serve your parents. Look for ways to help them. Offer to set the table or take out the trash.
- ☆ Thank your parents for the kind things they do for you. Tell them how much you love them.

2. What does God promise to those who honor their parents?

- ☆ Your life will be filled with God's favor and peace. Does this mean nothing bad will ever happen? No, but it does mean you will enjoy the blessings that come from doing things God's way.
