If you are a child of God, the Bible says this will never happen to you. God will never decide he doesn't want you anymore. He will never get rid of you or replace you with something else. Even when you are old and your body is worn out, God says, "I will carry you." Even when your hair is gray, God will still be faithful to you. He will never leave you or abandon you; he will be with you to the end.

Knowing this about God should encourage you to trust him for your whole life. The Bible says God made you in his image and you belong to him. If you are trusting in Jesus, God has also saved you from your sin and adopted you as his son or daughter. God loves you more than anyone else, even your dad and mom. God always knows what's best for you. That doesn't mean your life will always be easy, but it does mean that everything will be okay in the end. God wants you to trust him in every situation, because he is faithful.

What does it look like to trust in God's faithfulness?

- ☆ When you're afraid, remind yourself of this verse and thank God for being faithful to the end.
- ☆ Talk to God in prayer. Ask him to strengthen you and help you to trust him more fully.
- ☆ Obey God. Do what he tells you to do, because you want to please him, and because you know his way is the best way.
