Have you ever run out of something? Imagine you want cereal for breakfast. First, you get out a bowl and a spoon. Next, you open up a box of your favorite cereal and pour some into the bowl. Finally, you go to the refrigerator to get the milk. But when you pull out the container it's completely empty. How will you feel?

The Bible says there are two things that *never* run out: the love of God and the mercies of God. The mercies of God are all the ways in which he is good and kind to his children. These verses remind us that, if you are trusting in Jesus as your Savior, God will never stop loving you and doing good to you. Even when you sin against him or fail him, he will keep on faithfully loving you. Does God treat you this way because you deserve it? No. As sinners we haven't done anything to earn God's love and mercy. God loves us simply because he has chosen to love us. Does this mean your life will always be easy? No. But it does mean that God is still good even in the hard times. Can you think of some ways God has been good to you? Here are some ideas to get you started:

- ☆ God gives you good food to eat, clothes to wear, and a warm bed to sleep in (Philippians 4:19).
- ☆ God gives saves you from your sins and gives you new life in Jesus (John 3:16).
- ☆ God gives you his strength and promises to help you in the hard times (Isaiah 41:10).
- ☆ God hears and answers your prayers (John 15:7).
