*Recovery Home* will be the first home in Wisconsin to provide a safe place for women, 18 years and older, rescued from human trafficking. There are 300,000 American children forced into human trafficking every year. The average age is 12-14 and by the time they escape they are typically in need of a safe place to live, education and life skills. This home for survivors will include a personalized educational plan, job placement, trauma therapy, life skills, and medical assistance.
