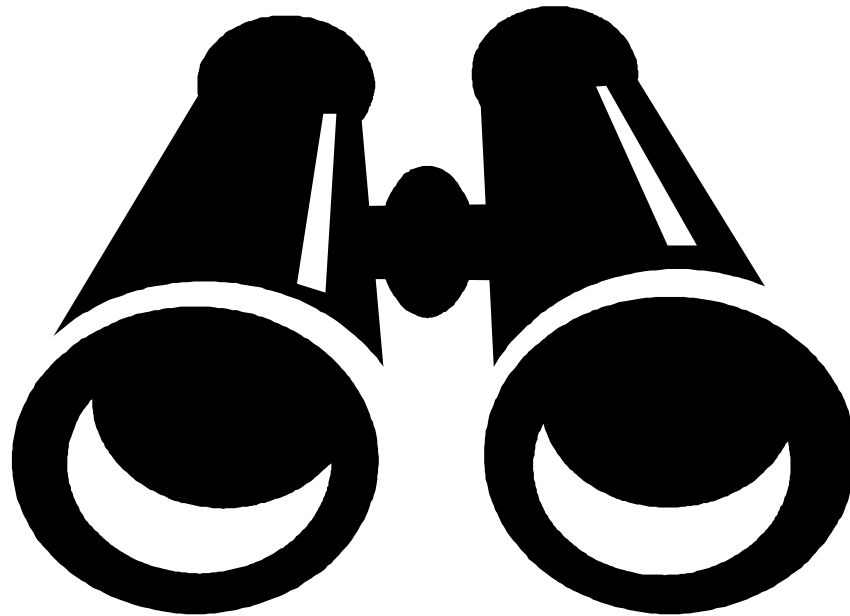

This verse tells us something important about God. What do we learn about God from this verse?

- God doesn't hide from us. He promised we will find Him if we seek Him.
- God wants us to seek Him with all our heart.
- God hears us when we pray.

What does it mean to seek God "with all your heart?"

- It means we understand how much we really need Him - that we are sinners who need a savior.
- It means that we treasure Him more than anyone or anything.

How do we seek God?

- By listening closely to the lesson each Sunday.
- By reading our Bible or listening to mom or dad read the Bible to us.
- By talking to God in prayer, asking Him to make Himself know to us.
