Eternal - God has no beginning and no end

How old are the mountains?

- The mountains are very, very old.
- They were here before the first man or woman.
- But God was here long before the mountains.

This verse reminds us that God is eternal. That means God has no beginning or end.

- There was never a time when God was not alive. There will never be a time when God will die.
- You were born on a specific day, your birthday. You had a beginning.
- God does not have a birthday. He has always existed and will always exist.

Why is it important to know that God is eternal?

- Will God ever die and not be God anymore? *(No! He will always be God.)*
- Will God ever not be there to be my friend anymore? *(Of course not! God will always be there to be my friend, just as He was a friend to Abraham, and Moses, and David.)*
- Will God ever not be there to do what He's promised? *(No! God will always keep His promises.)*
